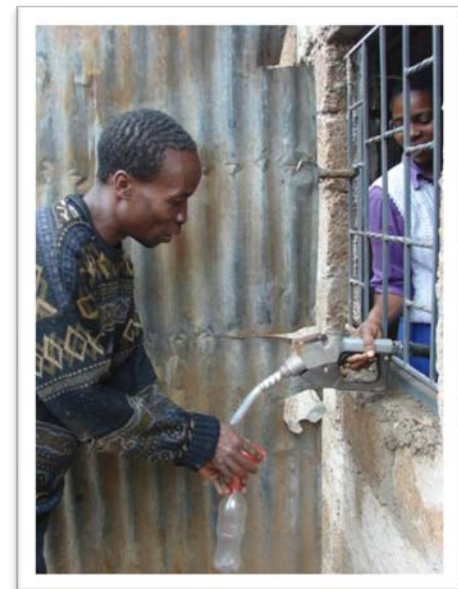
Together, we have provided business training, equipment and supplies to the caregiver of eight highly vulnerable children who live together in Kibera, southern Nairobi. With our help, Grace Kutwe is able to operate a local small business, selling kerosene and milled maize flour to her customers, and with her profits she is able to provide for the children in her care.

Now, the family has the opportunity to become financially self-sustaining. With a stable home life and a steady source of income, eight orphaned children who faced an uncertain future and were vulnerable to abuse instead have the opportunity to continue to attend school and Compassion's program, and to learn, grow and develop in a healthy environment.
