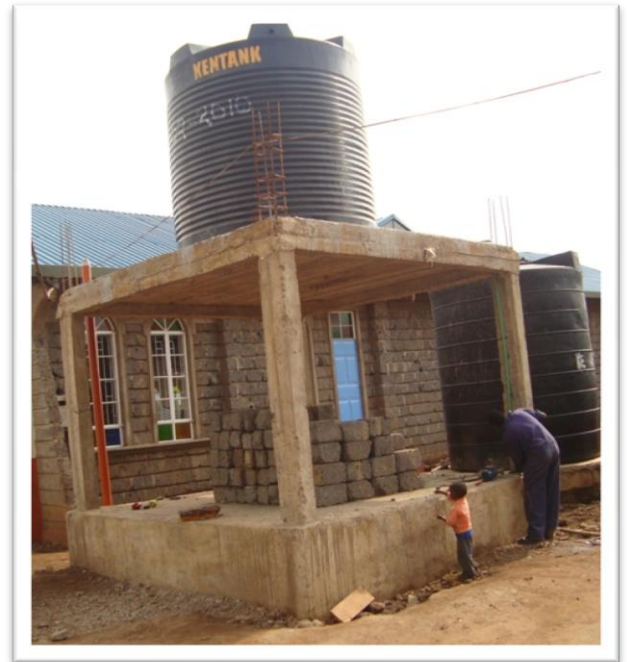

ORIGINAL PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The main objective of this critical intervention was to provide clean, safe, accessible water to the children and staff of KE-451, PEFA Kiwanja Child Development Centre.

The specific objectives follow:

- Construct an underground tank to provide safe, accessible water to the children and staff of the PEFA Kiwanja centre
- Reduce the incidence of waterborne diseases amongst registered children, parents and community members, through the provision of clean water and an accompanying water safety education campaign

ACTUAL PROJECT OUTCOMES

Thanks to your generous support, the construction of the underground water tank at the KE-451, PEFA Kiwanja Child Development Centre has been completed. Despite some difficulties—local roads flooded during the recent wet season, delaying the transportation of construction materials—the underground storage tank has been completed, a water catchment system has been constructed using the guttering of the local church building and the child development centre, and a small overhead tank has also been installed for ease of use.
